INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The LANDBANK Cash Management Fund aims to achieve capital preservation and income generation by investing in low-risk fixed-income instruments.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process shall be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The LANDBANK Cash Management Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- have a Moderate Risk Profile
- has an investment perspective which is short term in nature and willing to put all his/her/their money only in time deposits;
- · are willing to forego the higher long-term returns generated by riskier investment; and
- understands the risks of investing in products which are non-deposit, non-bank and with no recourse to the Bank.



NAVPU GRAPH ONE YEAR FUND PERFORMANCE



RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Fund has deposits with LANDBANK amounting to 1,781,427.25 which is within the limit approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, all related parties' transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

FUND MANAGER'S REPORT

The global and domestic macroeconomic backdrop is fraught with so many uncertainties due to high inflation and the tight global monetary policy this necessitated. Both the Federal Reserve and the European Central Bank have been raising interest rates since last year. This has pushed global yields to very high levels, exerting enormous pressure on the world economy. Apart from the foregoing, other factors that blight the global economic outlook are OPEC's propensity to keep oil prices at elevated levels, the Chinese economic slowdown, and the possibility that geopolitical flashpoints could accidentally be triggered. The confluence of all these events has led to the inversion of the U.S. yield curve which has more often than not, presaged a recession.

Meanwhile, on local shores, the Philippine yield curve, which used to have a positive slope, has already flattened quite considerably, with certain segments already inverted. Whether this leads to a Philippine recession or not is still conjecture. But one thing's for sure ... short-term interest rates have risen quite significantly. The prevailing conditions are thus a boon for money market funds, which could cash in on gains similar to those of long-term funds. Good times are in store for conservative investors.

VIEW STRATEGY

The raft of conflicting economic data which gave rise to many uncertainties, causing the yield curve to flatten is a dampener in and of itself. But inasmuch as this has caused the front end of the curve to jump, this has been a boon to conservative investors. Simply load up in the highest-yielding deposits and/or short-term treasuries.

Description of the Benchmark

Bloomberg's BVAL Evaluated Pricing Service provides transparent and highly defensible prices for fixed-income securities across the liquidity spectrum. The key to BVAL's methodology is its real-time access to market observations from a wealth of contributed sources. This accumulated mass of market data is the main driver of an innovative and quantitative approach that first corroborates market levels on actively traded bonds and then derives a comparable relative value price for those securities that are less liquid.

This methodology aligns with Bloomberg's trusted capabilities as the financial industry's leading analytics platform and source of fixed-income information. In addition to sophisticated algorithms that generate evaluated prices, the BVAL methodology assigns a BVAL Score based on the amount and consistency of market data used in Bloomberg models.

Key Characteristics

The Bloomberg Philippine Sovereign Bond Index Money Market is a rules based market-value weighted index engineered to measure the fixed rate and zero-coupon local currency local securities publicly issued by the Philippines, including retail securities. To be included in the index, a security must have a minimum par amount of PhP3 billion and a credit quality of BBB.

Relation to the fund's objectives/investment strategies

Designed for conservative investors with some risk appetite for a little extra yield, the fund is invested in a combination of deposit placements and short-term government securities. Investors of the fund can tolerate a little amount of volatility. As such, the Bloomberg Philippine Sovereign Bond Index Money Market (BPHILMM), dovetails the features, as well as the returns of the fund.
