OTHER CONDITIONS

1. The brand of the tube being offered should be specified in the bid proposal and should be at least five (5) years in the local market. Please submit copy of P.O. or contract as proof.

- 2. Prospective supplier must be at least 5 years in the supply and marketing of LED lighting system, it should submit sufficient proof of its compliance to this requirement in the form of certifications of satisfactory performance, POs or contracts from legitimate previous clients (Bank's, malls or similar institutions).
- 3. Winning supplier must submit sample of the offered product to FMD for approval prior to full delivery of items.
- 4. Winning supplier must provide 5% attic stocks to FMD to be used in case the delivered lighting becomes defective during the warranty period. The replenishment point of the supplier is when the 50% of the 5% attic stocks have been consumed. Attic stocks should be replaced/replenished by the supplier

- within 30 calendar days. Failure to do so will render the supplier concerned ineligible to participate in future procurement projects.
- 5. Prospective supplier should submit a list of the brand's authorized distributor/s and supplier/s in the Philippines to be submitted together with the bid proposal.

Statement of Compliance

Bidders must state below either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against each of the individual parameters of each specification.

Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's un-amended sales literature. unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid post-qualification evaluation, execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of ITB Clause 3.1(a)(ii) and/or GCC Clause 2.1(a)(ii)

The Technical Component (First Envelope) shall contain the following:

- Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting that the signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture (sample form - Form No.7).
- 2. Duly notarized Omnibus sworn statement (sample form Form No.6).
- 3. Eligibility requirements

• Legal Documents

- 3.a Registration certificate from SEC, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for sole proprietorship, or CDA for cooperatives, or any proof of such registration as stated in the Bidding Documents.
- 3.b Valid and current mayor's permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located.
- 3.c Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR.

Technical / Financial Documents

- 3.d Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. - 3.e Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid, equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC supported with contract/purchase order, enduser's acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the contract, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. - 3.f The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized Page 82 of 84

institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.

- 3.g The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (sample form Form No. 5).
- 3.h Valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit the legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance.
- 3.i Brochures or other equivalent documents indicating the complete specifications of the offered brand/model.
- 3.j Certification issued by the bidder stating that it has at least five (5) years experience in the supply and marketing of LED lighting system supported with certification of satisfactory performance, copy of Purchase Order, Contract or any other proofs from legitimate clients (bank, malls or similar institution).
