# Terms of Reference for the Supply, Delivery, Installation and Commissioning of 20Mbps Internet

### 1. Objectives:

The Terms of Reference aim to provide a framework for full TCP/IP Internet Service Provision for the LBP Security Office internet requirement for the real time monitoring of LBP Filed Offices CCTV system.

- Payment for the service shall be on a fixed monthly rate, VAT inclusive
- Capacity requirement: symmetric 20.0 Mbps bandwidth
- Connection type should be fiber-optic via router or switch with GE port
- The service should be highly stable and reliable. Overall uptime should be not less than 99.50%
- The provider must have 7x24x365 coverage for technical assistance and/or helpdesk facilities.

#### 2. Installation site:

16<sup>th</sup> Floor LBP Corporate Plaza, 1598 M.H. Del Pilar Street corner Dr. Quintos Street Malate Manila

### 3. Technical Requirements:

- Speed requirement: symmetric and dedicated 20.0 Mbps bandwidth
- Provider must be at least certified tier-2 ISP provider ( must provide certification)
- Connection type must be fiber-optic via router or switch with GE port
- No limitations on traffic/ports; subscribed bandwidth and service reliability must be ensured.
- Must provide Class C static publicly routable IP addresses
- All necessary hardware, cabling and software (if required for Internet service) should be provided and set up by the provider.
- Latency shall be no more than 90 ms. . This is the allowable amount of time for the data to reach Service Provider's local node from LBP Server. Ping test may be used to measure the latency.
- Internet service to be provided to LANDBANK must have a DDOS protection. Please provide certification.
- Worldwide accessibility
- Must provide Quality of Service and Policy on over subscription (sharing ratio 1:1 to guarantee bandwidth). A dedicated symmetric internet subscription wherein the speed of download and upload must be closely identical.

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- ISP must be able to manage the Customer Premises Equipment (CPE) to be installed in the LBP Office
- Free and unlimited technical support
- Vendor must provide unique access to Multi-Router Traffic Grapher (MRTG) for the monitoring of usage and bandwidth.

### 5. Implementation Timeline:

All installation works should be accomplished and connection launched within 45 days after the signing of the Contract.

## 6. Contractual and payment stipulations:

- Payment for the service shall be on a fixed monthly rate, VAT inclusive
- Contract duration: 3-years. The Procuring Entity may terminate the contract, in whole or
  in part, at any time for its convenience. The Head of the Procuring Entity may terminate
  a contract for the convenience of the Government if he has determined the existence of
  conditions that the Project Implementation economically, financially or technically
  impractical and/or unnecessary, such as, but not limited to, fortuitous event(s) or
  changes in the law and national government policies.

# 7. Qualification Requirements and Additional Terms and Conditions:

- a. 5 years relevant experience in provision of services in nature, scale and complexity commensurate with the present terms of reference, with already provided services possessing features required by these terms of reference.
- b. The vendor must have at least three similar contracts (similar by scope, nature and amount), preferably with private/ intergovernmental organizations. Evidences of these contracts are required.
- Seven days a week and 24 hours per day coverage for technical assistance and/or helpdesk facilities. Any problem should be resolved within 2 hours after the notification.
- d. The vendor must have a Network Monitoring System (NMS) supported by a qualified and experienced engineers/technical support team. NMS report must always be available and must be provided to LBP monthly and when required.

The delivery schedule expressed as weeks/months stipulates hereafter a delivery date which is the date of delivery to the project site.

- 2. Duly notarized Omnibus sworn statement (sample form Form No.6).
- 3. Eligibility requirements (Section 23.1)

## Legal Documents

- 3.a Registration certificate from SEC, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for sole proprietorship, or CDA for cooperatives, or any proof of such registration as stated in the Bidding Documents.
- 3.b Valid and current mayor's permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located.
- 3.c Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR.

### Technical / Financial Documents

- 3.d Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the PBDs prescribed by the GPPB. (sample form Form No. 3) Note: This form may no longer be submitted if bidder has no on-going contracts.
- 3.e Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC supported with contract/purchase order, end-user's acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the contract, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the PBDs prescribed by the GPPB. (sample form Form No. 4).

- 3.f The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.
- 3.g The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (sample form Form No. 5).
- 3.h Valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit the legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance.
- 3.i Certification issued by the bidder stating that it has at least five (5) years relevant experience in the provision of services in nature, scale and complexity commensurate with the present terms of reference.
- 3.j List of at least three similar projects (similar by scope, nature and amount), preferably with private/inter-governmental organizations supported with copy of Purchase Order, contract or any other proof.
- 3.k Certification issued by the bidder stating that it has a Network Monitoring System.
- 3.1 List of qualified and experienced engineers/technical support team.
- 4. Bid security in the prescribed form, amount and validity period (ITB Clause 18.1 of the Bid Data Sheet);
- 5. Revised Schedule VI Schedule of Requirements with signature of bidder's authorized representative.
- 6. Revised Section VII Specifications with response on compliance and signature of bidder's authorized representative.
