- 1. PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration under Platinum Membership (all documents enumerated in its Annex A must be updated); or all of the following:
 - Registration Certificate from SEC, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for sole proprietorship, or CDA for cooperatives, or any proof of such registration as stated in the Bidding Documents;
 - Valid and current mayor's/business permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located, or equivalent document for Exclusive Economic Zones or Areas; and
 - Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR.

Technical Eligibility Documents

- 2. Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 3).
- 3. Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC supported with contract/purchase order, end-user's acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the contract, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 4).
- 4. Bid security in the prescribed form, amount and validity period (ITB Clause 18.1 of the Bid Data Sheet).

- 5. Section VI Schedule of Requirements with signature of bidder's authorized representative.
- 6. Revised Section VII Specifications with response on compliance and signature of bidder's authorized representative.
- 7. Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (sample form Form No.6).
- 8. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting that the signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture (sample form Form No. 7).

The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.
- 10. The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) following the sample form (Form No. 5), or in the case of Procurement of Goods, a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank.
- o Eligibility Documents Class "B"
 - 11. Valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit its legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance, provided, that the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the statement of all its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

A. Name and Description of the Project

Two (2) year lease 38 units of Brand-new TWO-WAY RADIO including all subscription fees for official use ECLPERT/ FERT/ WERT/ NERT units in line with the emergency preparedness program in LBP Plaza.

B. Objective of the Project

The TWO-WAY RADIO shall be for official use of Floor Emergency Response Teams (FERT), Week-end Emergency Response Team (WERT)/ Night-time Emergency Response Team (NERT) as means of communication during drills and actual emergencies such as fire, earthquake, bomb explosion, etc. It will also strengthen the Bank's Emergency Preparedness Program by promoting teamwork and camaraderie. The use of TWO-WAY RADIO will improve the response of all members of the Environmental Changes and LANDBANK Plaza Emergency Response Teams (ECLPERT).

Units not restored to normal operation beyond 48 hours shall be replaced immediately by the winning bidder without additional cost to the Bank. Corresponding deductions will be effected by LANDBANK from the receivables of the winning contractor for every day of non-use due to defects of units, devices, signals and the like.
