In case the existing camera/s failed to integrate with the NVR, the winning bidder must:

- Upgrade the firmware in order to be recognized by the NVR.
- If not recognized by the NVR, an Inspection Report shall be submitted by the installer and duly noted by the concerned Branch Head.

Ensure that all the existing IP cameras at the branches/ extension offices are integrated and activated with the new NVR to be supplied.

Payment shall be based on the actual devices installed.

Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its single largest completed contract similar to the contract to be bid, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC supported with contract/purchase order, end-user's acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the contract, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the PBDs prescribed by the GPPB. (sample form Form No. 4).
- 3.d. The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (sample form Form No. 5).

- 3.e. Valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit the legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance.
- 3.f. Brochures or other official documents coming from the manufacturer indicating the complete specifications of the brand/model being offered.
