The LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (LANDBANK), through its Corporate Budget for the contract approved by the Board of Directors for 2020 intends to apply the total sum of Sixteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos Only (P16,200,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract to payments under the contract for the Supply, Delivery, Installation and Configuration of Network and Security Automated Backup & Recovery Solution with Hardware Infrastructure with Three (3) Years Warranty/ITB No.LBP-HOBAC-ITB-GS-20200326-01.
