Going beyond the extra mile in service

LANDBANK continues to deliver cash assistance to Filipinos across the nation

LANDBANK Culasi Branch personnel took a 4-hour boat ride to distribute LANDBANK cash cards to social protection beneficiaries in the remote islands of the Municipality of Caluya, Antique.

Around 7.6 million beneficiaries under the major social protection programs of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) across the nation received their government subsidy through LANDBANK's continued disbursement efforts for CY 2022.

The Bank goes above and beyond to reach even the most far-flung communities, travelling by land, sea, and air to provide cash grants to 4.4 million Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT) beneficiaries and 3.2 million Unconditional Cash Transfer (UCT) beneficiaries.

In 2022, LANDBANK disbursed a total of P103.90B in cash grants to beneficiaries of the CCT and UCT Programs.

"In addition to ensuring the timely and secure transfer of government subsidies its beneficiaries, the issuance of LANDBANK cash cards optimizes our efforts to bring more Filipinos into the formal banking system as part of our support to the National Government's thrust for inclusive and sustainable development," LANDBANK President and CEO Lynette V. Ortiz said.

Beneficiaries can use the LANDBANK cash cards to conveniently withdraw their cash aid from ATMs and from LANDBANK Agent Banking Partner (ABP) in local communities.

The LANDBANK cash cards can also receive funds from other LANDBANK accounts through fund transfers via the iAccess, the LANDBANK Remittance System (LBRS) for overseas remittances, ATMs, and from other bank accounts via InstaPay and ATM fund transfers.

Beneficiaries may likewise use the cash cards for cashless transactions in groceries, pharmacies, convenience stores, and other accepting merchants via POS terminals.

LANDBANK is the main distribution arm of financial assistance of the National Government. The Bank has also assisted in the disbursement of other subsidy programs, notably those from DSWD's Targeted Cash Transfer Program, DA's Rice

LANDBANK maintained its rank as one of the Top Ten Universal and Commercial Banks (UKBs) in the country as of the first quarter of 2023.

The Bank sustained its position as the second largest bank in terms of assets and deposits after respectively obtaining an 11.7% and 13.7% increase as of March 31, 2023. Meanwhile, the Bank maintained its fourth position in terms of loans and capital after

earning a moderate year-on-year increase at 10.2% and 3.2% in growth rate, respectively.

The ranking of the Top Ten UKBs was based on the published Statements of Condition (SOC) of Philippine Banks, the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP), Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Philippine Stock Exchange (PSE), Philippine Dealing System (PDS), and press releases.
