TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Liquidated Damage for Procurement of Goods, Supplies, Materials and Services, when
the supplier fails to satisfactorily deliver goods / services under the contract within the
specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the supplier
shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated
damages, not by way of penalty, an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent
(1%) of the cost of delayed goods / services scheduled for delivery for every day of
delay until such goods / services are finally delivered and accepted by LANDBANK.

LANDBANK need not to prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Such amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due to the supplier, or collected from any securities or warranties posted by the supplier, whichever is convenient to LANDBANK. In no case shall the total sum of liquidated damages exceed ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, in which event LANDBANK shall automatically rescind the contract and impose appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages to be paid, in accordance with the Revised IRR of RA 9184.

- 2. Payment of this Purchase Order is subject to the LANDBANK's and COA's accounting/auditing rules and regulations and pertinent revenue laws and regulations.
- 3. For the Procurement of goods, in order to assume that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the supplier, a warranty security shall be required from the contract awardees for a minimum period of three (3) months, In case of Expandable Supplies, or a minimum period of one (1) year, in case of Non-Expandable Supplies, after acceptance by LANDBANK of the delivered supplies.

The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least one percent (3%) of every progress payment, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least one percent (3%) of the total contract price. The said amounts shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period or, in case of Expandable Supplies, after consumption thereof: Provided, however that the supplies delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.

4. In view of the implementation of the LANDBANK's Environmental Management System, please ensure that your delivery / service vehicles are not smoke belchers. Otherwise we shall not allow entry of your vehicle in our premises. We thank you for your cooperation.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of the Contract referred to.
- 2) The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. the Bid Form and the Price Schedule submitted by the Bidder;
 - b. the Schedule of Requirements;
 - c. the Technical Specifications;
 - d. the General Conditions of the Contract;
 - e. the Special Conditions of the Contract; and
 - f. the Entity's Notice of Award

Section I. THE PROJECT

1. Purpose of the Memorandum of Agreement

This Agreement is entered into to formalize the intent of DSWD Programs between LANDBANK and **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** to effectively and efficiently deliver cash assistance through adopting the use of manual or over-the-counter payout and digital payment to the beneficiaries and clients of DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V through LANDBANK, as pilot

arrangement in DSWD Field Offices II, III, IV-A (CALABARZON), V and National Capital Region (NCR).

This agreement is entered into due to the following:

- 1.1 To implement the inclusion of other DSWD programs and projects as stated in the 9th whereas clause of the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) Program MOA between DSWD and LANDBANK executed on May 21, 2024, to incorporate Ayuda sa Kapos ang Kita Program (AKAP) and other DSWD programs and projects for the implementation of the Hybrid Digital Digital Payout of Assistance to DSWD's eligible beneficiaries and clients in selected areas of DSWD Field Offices.
- 1.2 To implement the main MOA dated 21 May 2024, Addendum to the MOA dated 16 August 2024 and Supplemental MOA dated 07 January 2025, all its provisions shall now also cover and be applicable to all qualified AICS, AKAP and other DSWD programs and projects' beneficiaries subject to their respective guidelines.
- 1.3 To adopt the use of manual or over-the-counter payout and digital payment of financial assistance to the beneficiaries and clients of AICS, AKAP and other programs and projects by DSWD through LANDBANK, as a pilot arrangement in select areas of all DSWD Field Offices.
- 1.4 To formalize the intent of DSWD Programs between LANDBANK and BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. to effectively and efficiently deliver financial assistance to the beneficiaries and clients of AICS, AKAP and other programs and projects by DSWD.

2. Scope and Structure of Agreement

- 2.1 This MOA will cover BSP-supervised Service Providers with existing business relationship with LANDBANK (with existing deposit account with LANDBANK) and have the capability to undertake over-the-counter (OTC) offsite payment (onsite/branch office of the conduit, difficult areas and GIDA) to DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V beneficiaries down to the barangay level.
- 2.2 The BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC., in coordination with DSWD, may provide a covered waiting area for DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V beneficiaries during the conduct of distribution of cash assistance.
- 2.3 The BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall provide payment distribution service with sufficient logistics to support the implementation of DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V in the areas and payout period set by DSWD.







2.4 The BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall open dedicated regular deposit funding accounts with LANDBANK prior to payout (please see Annex A for the details of Opening of Account in the Funding of Cash Assistance).

Section II. DEPOSIT HOLD-OUT

- <u>Deposit Hold-out</u> (BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. to assign and maintain hold-out account subject to lifting of hold upon submission of liquidation documents).
 - 1.1. **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** shall establish/open and maintain dedicated Deposit Accounts with LANDBANK Legazpi Branch, as follows:

- 1.2. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch shall advise BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. of the deficiency in the Deposit Account in case the deposit balance should fall below the required minimum maintaining balance (standard bank charges apply if applicable).
- 1.3. BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall authorize LANDBANK Legazpi Branch to hold the deposit balance on the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Hold-out Account equivalent to the amount of payroll funded by DSWD for the distribution of cash assistance







to the beneficiaries before credit to the **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** Funding Account.

 BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall conduct payout using the funds credited to BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Funding Account.

Note: **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** shall conduct payout based on the clean and final payroll files from LANDBANK Servicing Branch as sent by DSWD through secured network or other electronic means (e.g., email – file shall be with password).

- 1.5 BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall submit the following liquidation documents to DSWD Regional/Field Office (copy furnished LANDBANK Legazpi Branch) not later than five (5) banking days after the payout date in order for LANDBANK Legazpi Branch to lift the amount in the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Holdout Account (subject to pro-rated lifting, equivalent to paid beneficiaries):
 - Digital (digitally signed) or original Liquidation Certification Certification of Paid and Unpaid Transactions for the payouts conducted (Exhibit 1);
 - Soft copy of response files with data on the name of paid beneficiaries, amount paid and date paid; and
 - Soft copy of list of unpaid beneficiaries.
- 1.6 LANDBANK Legazpi Branch shall debit BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Funding Account and credit DSWD's Program Fund Account the amount equivalent to the total unpaid cash assistance based on the copy of the liquidation documents submitted not later than five (5) banking days after the payout date.

In case of failure to return the unpaid cash assistance using the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Funding Account, the LANDBANK Legazpi Branch shall debit BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Hold-out Account equivalent to the amount of unpaid cash assistance.

Section III. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1.1. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Open BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Funding (non-interest-bearing current account) and Service Fee (non-interest-bearing current account) Accounts and open/assign BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Hold-out Account as authorized by the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.






- 1.2. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Receive the clean and final payroll files (list of beneficiaries/clients) provided by DSWD transmitted electronically within three (3) banking days before the target schedule of payout through secured network or other electronic means (e.g., email – file shall be with password) as may be agreed upon by DSWD and LANDBANK).
- LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Provide to BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. the clean and final payroll files upon receipt from DSWD.
- 1.4. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Debit from the respective DSWD's Program Fund Account the amount corresponding to the amount in the Letter of Instruction (LOI) based on DSWD's approved payroll and credit the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON'S, INC. Funding Account.
- LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Hold the amount in the assigned BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Hold-out Account equivalent to DSWD's approved payroll.
- 1.6. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Lift the amount in the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Hold-out Account (subject to pro-rated lifting) based on the copy of the following liquidation documents submitted by the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. to DSWD Regional/Field Office not later than five (5) banking days after the payout date:

 - Soft copy of response files with data on the name of paid beneficiaries, amount paid and date paid; and

- 1.7. LANDBANK Legazpi Branch Debit BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Funding Account and credit to DSWD's Program Fund Account the amount equivalent to the total unpaid cash grants upon receipt of the copy of the abovementioned liquidation documents not later than five (5) banking days after the payout date.

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- 2.3 Submit a plan on securing the money before, during and after the payout against theft, or robbery, loss and other fortuitous events.
- 2.4 Conform with DSWD on the agreed payout schedule (date, time and venue).

- 2.5 Strictly follow the distribution of cash assistance based on the agreed date, time and venue.
- 2.6 Ensure that security measures are in place in order to safeguard the withdrawal and transport of cash assistance.
- 2.7 Validate and confirm receipt of the clean and final payroll files from LANDBANK Legazpi Branch as sent by DSWD through secured network or other electronic means (e.g., email – file shall be with password).
- 2.8 Provide payment distribution service with sufficient logistics to support the implementation of DSWD Programs in the areas and payout period set by DSWD.
- 2.9 Provide a special lane and a covered waiting area for DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V beneficiaries during the conduct of distribution of cash assistance.
- 2.10 Conduct payout using the funds credited to the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON's, INC. Funding Account based on payroll funding schedule set by DSWD.

Note: **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** shall conduct payout based on the clean and final payroll files from LANDBANK Servicing Branch as sent by DSWD through secured network or other electronic means (e.g., email – file shall be with password).

- 2.11 Ensure the DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V payouts conducted for the day are reconciled based on the following:
 - Actual cash assistance distributed to beneficiaries and the remaining cash on hand, if any; and
 - Payroll files.
- 2.12 Submit the following liquidation documents to DSWD Regional/Field Office (copy furnished LANDBANK Legazpi Branch) not later than five (5) banking days after the payout date in order for LANDBANK Legazpi Branch to lift the amount in the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. Holdout Account (subject to pro-rated lifting, equivalent to paid beneficiaries):

Note: **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** shall sign the DSWD-reconciled Liquidation Report upon receipt from DSWD Regional/Field Office and return the same to DSWD Regional/Office after signing.

 Digital (digitally signed) or original Liquidation Certification – Certification of Paid and Unpaid Transactions for the payouts conducted (Exhibit 1);





- Soft copy of response files with data on the name of paid beneficiaries, amount paid and date paid; and
- Soft copy of list of unpaid beneficiaries.
- 2.13 In the event of request for extension by DSWD Regional/Field Office to BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. to conduct distribution of cash assistance to beneficiaries beyond the scheduled payout day (copy furnished LANDBANK Legazpi Branch), the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall comply with the new scheduled payout date and the following:
 - Submit to the authorized staff of the DSWD Regional/Field Office the requirements in item 2.12 for reconciliation, which will then be the basis for the payment of service fees.
 - Submit to DSWD Regional/Field Office (copy furnished LANDBANK Legazpi Branch) the billing of service fees for the distributed cash assistance.

For any payout schedule, DSWD to provide Notice of Rescheduled Payout in the identified email of the **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.**, (copy furnished **LANDBANK Legazpi Branch**)

- 2.14 BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall submit to DSWD the billing of service fees for the distributed cash assistance within three (3) banking days after the reconciliation.
- 2.15 Conduct periodic monitoring for the enhancement of program activities as the case may be.
- 2.16 Allow the DSWD and its authorized representative (s) to view, generate, download and print any data/reports necessary to attain its reconciliation and COA's post objectives pursuant to COA Circular No. 2020-010 dated December 2, 2020 such as history of payment records.
- 2.17 Maintain e-payroll liquidation files, records of disbursement and liquidation certification for a minimum period of ten (10) years for backup.
- 2.18 Assist in the conduct of Registration Caravan of PISO Plus as the need arises.

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Section IV. FEES AND CHARGES

BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall receive the following corresponding service fee for the following areas (less all applicable taxes) per successfully paid DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V beneficiaries based on the liquidation documents submitted to DSWD Regional/Field Office:

No Service Fee shall be credited to the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. unless liquidation documents are fully submitted by BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC..

The Bank, with the LOI of DSWD, shall only pay the service fees for the actual number of beneficiaries served for DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V cash assistance payment. The actual number of beneficiaries may be increased or decreased depending on the mapping list and payroll files provided by DSWD to LANDBANK.

Section V. LIABILITIES AND WARRANTIES

- The parties undertake on best efforts basis to comply with their respective obligations as described in this Agreement so as to deliver the best quality of services for the DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V.
- Failure of BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. to perform the service as required therein, to the DSWD and LANDBANK's satisfaction, or any violation of the terms and conditions of the Contract, shall entitle LANDBANK the right to terminate the Contract and forfeit the performance bond in its favor.
- Each of the party shall be solely liable for the proper execution of their respective duties and responsibilities enumerated in Section III, hereof.
- The parties ensure and bear the sole responsibility, that no provision under this Agreement contravene the rights of any third party with whom any of the





parties may have contractual obligation/s and any applicable Philippine law or regulation.

Section VI. CONFIDENTIALITY

- LANDBANK and BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. agree to be bound by the obligations of confidentiality set forth in this Agreement. Moreover, LANDBANK acknowledges the propriety character of BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. and therefore, agrees not to use any specifications developed for the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. facility in any bid or other specification document for the same or similar service with any other Service Provider.
- During the term of this Agreement, and all times thereafter, LANDBANK and BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. undertake not to divulge to any third party, except to DSWD, any information regarding any operations, practices, specifications, account balances and transactions, personal data of clients, and activities of each contracting party.
- Each Party agrees to hold in strict confidence any Confidential Information disclosed to or obtained by it and shall use such Confidential Information only in connection with the purposes of this Agreement.
 - a. For purposes of this provision, Confidential Information means any and all information disclosed by a Party (Disclosing Party) to, or obtained by, the other Party (Receiving Party) in any manner, that, as a result of, or in connection with this Agreement, by its nature, is considered proprietary and confidential, regardless of whether such information is specifically labeled or described as such including, but not limited to, proprietary information, personal data, financial data, business plans or proposals, agreements of the Disclosing Party with third parties, and any representation by any officer, employee or representative of the Disclosing Party. Provided, however, that Confidential Information shall not include the following:
 - Information that is generally available to the public other than as a result of disclosure in violation of this Agreement
 - Information available to the Receiving Party on non-confidential basis without an express restriction on disclosure;
 - Information which is required to be disclosed by any court, tribunal or regulatory authority or by any requirement of law, legal process or regulation; or
 - Information that the Disclosing Party expressly agrees in writing may be disclosed by the Receiving Party to third parties.
 - b. The Receiving Party agrees that Confidential Information shall not be disclosed to third parties without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party, and that each Party shall exercise the same degree of care as it applies to protect its

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own confidential information of similar nature that it does not desire to publish, disclose, or disseminate. This obligation of confidentiality shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement.

- 4. Each Party shall, in accordance with the Data Privacy Act, ensure that appropriate organizational, physical, and technical measures are in place to maintain the confidentiality, integrity and security of all personal data that may come to its knowledge or possession by reason of any provision of this Agreement and that its employees, agents, representatives, or any person acting under its authority shall hold personal information under strict confidentiality at all times.
 - 5. Both parties shall defend, indemnify, and hold its officers, representatives and employees, free and harmless from and against all claims, damages, liabilities and costs of every kind and character resulting from or relating to the inaccuracy, nonfulfillment, negligence, breach of established protocols/safeguards, or breach of any representation, warranty, covenant or obligation of the offending party.
 - If any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.
 - 7. The Parties shall endeavor in good faith to settle any claim, dispute or controversy through compromise or amicable settlement. However, in the event that the Parties fail to reach any settlement within a reasonable period, all claims, disputes and controversies arising from or relating to this Agreement shall be brought before the proper courts of the City of Legazpi to the exclusion of all other courts.

Section VII. NON-LIABILITY

LANDBANK and **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** shall not be liable for any loss or damage of whatever nature in connection with transactions involving the DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V disbursement through **BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC.** such as but not limited to any of the following instances:

- Disruption, failure or delay relating to or in connection with due to circumstances beyond the control of LANDBANK BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC., such as fortuitous events, but not limited to typhoons, floods, public disturbances and calamities and other similar or related cases.
- Inaccurate, incomplete or delayed information received due to disruption or failure of any communication facilities used for the BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON's, INC. disbursement.
- Indirect, incidental, or consequential loss, loss of profit or damage that the DSWD's AICS Program and AKAP in Region V beneficiaries may suffer or has

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suffered by reason of failure/inability to conduct payout under the terms of this Agreement.

4. Notwithstanding the foregoing, LANDBANK shall hold BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. free and harmless from all damages resulting from or in connection with this Agreement, except if such damages are attributable to the fault or negligence of BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. or any of its officers or personnel.

Section VIII. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- The provisions of this Agreement shall be subject to existing applicable laws of the Philippines, particularly the General Appropriations Act (GAA) governing the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation, Government Procurement Act (RA 9184) and the rules and regulations of the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas, National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) and the existing policies of LANDBANK and BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. as well as those that maybe promulgated thereafter.
- The Parties agree to provide further assistance and execute such documents as may be necessary or reasonably desirable to accomplish the intents and purposes of this Agreement.
- Any change or modification in the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall mutually be agreed upon by LANDBANK and BANCO SANTIAGO DE LIBON, INC. shall be incorporated herein by way of an addendum/addenda concurred and signed by both parties.
- 4. This Agreement shall be subject to a review, after each payout by the parties hereto for the purpose of determining necessary amendments or the continued effectivity thereof (e.g. Inability to schedule and conduct payout may be a ground for non-compliance of the contract.).

Section IX. ARBITRATION CLAUSE

Any and all disputes arising from the implementation of this contract shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provisions of Republic Act No. 876 otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law".

- In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Entity to provide the goods and services and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
- The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract.

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Section X. EFFECTIVITY

This Agreement shall take effect upon immediately upon its execution, and shall remain in effect for one (1) year, unless earlier pre-terminated.
