INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

To generate long-term capital growth, to the extent possible, through investments mainly in peso-denominated listed equities comprising the Philippine Stock Exchange Index (PSEi). The fund is suitable for investors who are willing to take extra risk in order to avail of the higher investment returns offered by the equities market.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A *client profiling process* should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The LANDBANK Equity Index Fund is classified as a Balanced Fund suitable only for investors who:

- Have an Aggressive risk profile
- Can accept the risk that the principal investment can be lost in whole or in part
- With an investment horizon of 5 to 7 years.

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

Credit Risk/Default Risk. The risk of losses due to a borrower's failure to pay principal and/or interest in a timely manner on instruments such as bonds, loans, or other forms of security which the borrower issued.

Reinvestment Risks. The risk associated with the possibility of having lower returns or earnings when maturing funds or the interest earnings of funds are reinvested.

- The Fund implements a risk management policy that applies the principles of Value-at-Risk (VAR) and Modified Duration. VaR is defined as a statistical estimate of the amount of loss that an "open" risk position is unlikely to exceed during a given time period with a given level of confidence. Modified Duration is a means to measure the change in the value of a security in response to a change in interest rates. The formula is used to determine the effect that a 1% change in interest rates will have on the price of the bond.
- The Fund's investment outlets have been subject to proper screening and evaluation in accordance with LANDBANK – TBG's accreditation process and minimum regulatory requirements.

REDEMPTION CONDITIONS

Surrender of the Confirmation of Participation; subject to penalty if redeemed before the minimum holding period. For Partial Redemption, remaining balance should not be less than minimum investment.

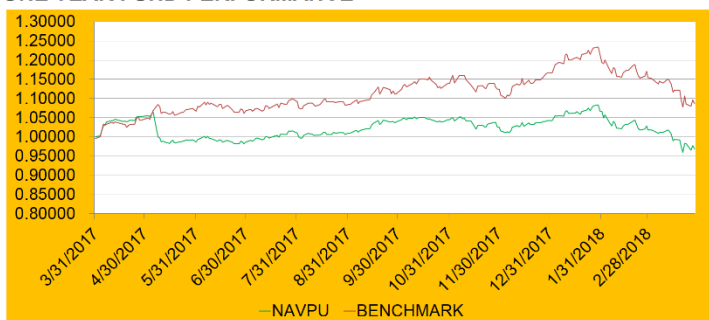

ONE YEAR FUND PERFORMANCE

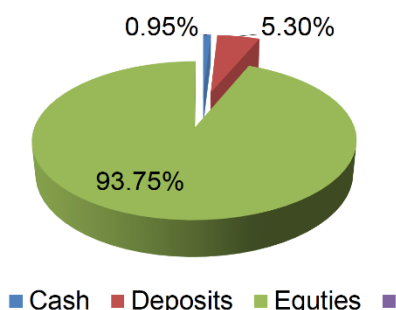

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Fund has deposits with LANDBANK amounting to P6,080,520.73, which is within the limit approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, related parties transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

FUND MANAGER'S REPORT

The country's economy expanded 6.6% during the fourth quarter, a tad below market consensus of 6.7% and lower than prior quarter's remarkable 6.9%. Data shows significant contributors to growth are investments, domestic as well as government spending, and still the services and industrial sector which rose above 7.0%..

The PSEi ending 2017 at an all-time high above 8,500 levels ascended to breach even 9,000 at month-end of January. However, the index began to progressively decline throughout the rest of the quarter amid inflation concerns locally. Furthermore fears of a US-China trade war remained to weigh down on the index. As of end-March PSEi closed on a negative note (-0.69) at 7979.83.

The Dow Jones Index plunged to 23,848.42 to close the first quarter amidst looming tariffs and a global trade war. NASDAQ Composite Index ended at 6,949.77, also down from a high of 7,588.33 on March 12, 2018. Early in February spelled turmoil in the markets as inflation fears directed bond yields higher. Investors became wary of economic strength reinforced by tax reforms as such may translate into more tightening by the Fed.

VIEW STRATEGY

To minimize the volatility due external tensions between China and the US, and uncertain state of the global economy in the fund, we've had substantially increase our cash position by reducing our exposures on equities, and shorten the portfolio duration. Moving forward, our strategy is to deliberately accumulate underperforming stocks within the index, and eventually lengthen the fund's portfolio duration by adding fixed income on the medium to long-end of the yield curve for higher yield.
