INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The LANDBANK Money Market Fund aims to provide investors high liquidity and minimal risk but with decent returns on their capital, from special savings deposit accounts and other interest bearing deposits.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

The LANDBANK Money Market Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- Have a Conservative Risk Profile
- With an Investment Horizon of < 1 year

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

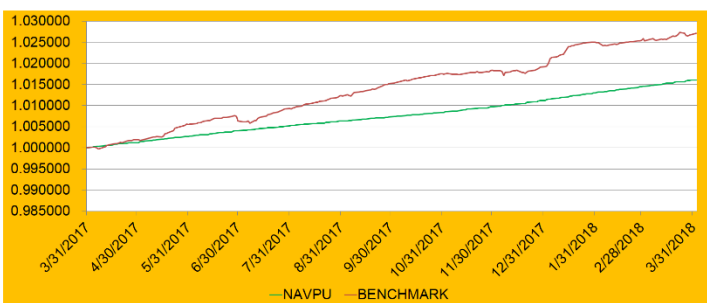

ONE YEAR FUND PERFORMANCE

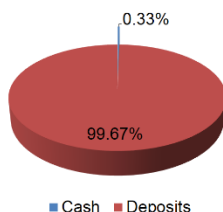

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Fund has deposits with LANDBANK amounting to Php39,800,000.00 which is within the limit approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, all related parties transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

FUND MANAGER'S REPORT

The Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas has once again stood firm against policy rate adjustments in their most recent meeting of the first quarter. Overnight lending rate is still at 3.5%; overnight reverse repurchase rate at 3.0%; and overnight deposit rate at 2.5%. The decision is based on the outlook for inflation which although is accelerating for the past months, is perceived to stabilize along target (2.0 – 4.0%) coming into 2019. Nevertheless, BSP governor Espenilla announced that should inflationary pressures persist, appropriate measures are ready to be employed in order to maintain its primary objective of financial stability.

The PSA released March CPI at 4.3% using the 2012 base year citing price surges in commodity goods as a reflection of higher costs from the enactment of TRAIN. The rate increased from February's revised 3.8% (also using 2012 base year) comparing to the market survey of 4.2%

Philippine Government Securities yields originated from a sideward trend beginning of the year to steepen entering February as the inflation print for January came at 4.0% - at the top end of the government's target. To add, analysts have interpreted the central bank's remarks as somewhat hawkish alongside expectations of a March rate hike by the Fed. The 10-year benchmark bond FXTB 10-60 ended the quarter at 5.637%, while the 10-year US Treasury note ended at 2.740%.

VIEW STRATEGY

For the Fund to maximize investment in banks high yielding deposits as interest rate is increasing. Alternative investment is in long-term deposit with high interest rate than regular term deposit.
