INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The LANDBANK Money Market Plus Fund aims to achieve liquidity and potential higher income from short-term fixed income investments.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

The LANDBANK Money Market Plus Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- Have a Moderate Risk Profile
- With an Investment Horizon of 1-3 years

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

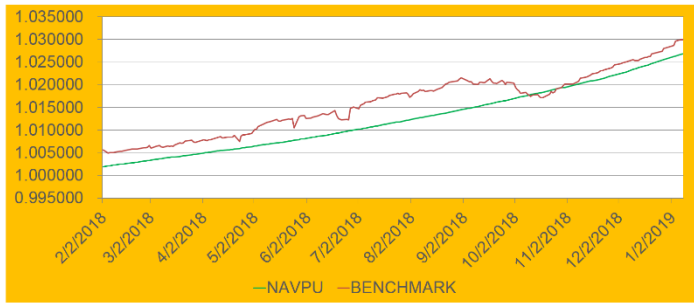

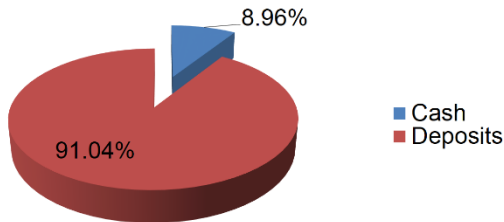

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Fund has deposits with LANDBANK amounting to PhP851,321.00 which is within the limit approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, all related parties transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

FUND MANAGER'S REPORT

The Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas raised interest rates another 25 basis points in November to conclude the series of tightening measures beginning in May. This brings a cumulative of 175 basis points increase in key policy rates to 4.25-5.25% by the end of the year. While inflation plateaued in the beginning of the fourth quarter, suggesting a decelerating momentum forward, the decision came in a proactive move to arrest further second-round effects. Well enough, domestic and global price pressures receded to support the lower path ahead. Forecasts now consider the consumer price index to settle within the 2-4.0% target in 2019-2020. Thus and so, monetary policy at current settings remain appropriate to allow previous adjustments to work their way through the economy.

VIEW STRATEGY

Investments for the fourth quarter of 2018 were kept on the short ends as inflationary concerns governed key interest rates. The Fund will continue to maximize investment allocation to banks with high yielding deposit products for optimal returns and have short-dated investment that will be used for the funds liquidity requirements. Rates of Government Treasury Bills will be monitored with the interest of the fund to purchase for trading gain opportunity.
